19.0	Junction: US Interstate HIghway 10	Junction of Arizona Highway US 95 & US Interstate Highway 10. US 95 turns west at this point and merges with US Interstate 10. Community of Quartzsite, La Paz County, Arizona. Popular RV camping destination during the winter.
45.9	Kofa National Wildlife Refuge, AZ	Northeast of Yuma and southeast of Quartsite, Arizona is the Kofa National Wildlife Refuge, established in 1939, 665,400 acres, excellent site to see desert plants and wildlife. Regulated hunting, rock climbing, camping, hiking. Be cautious of unexploded ordnance as Gen. George S. Patton conducted WW II desert military training in Kofa.
60.5	Castle Dome Mountains, AZ	Castle Dome Mountain range, Yuma County, Arizona. Highest point of the mountain range is Castle Dome Peak, 3,776 feet high. Once named Cabeza de Gigante (Giant's Head) by the early Spanish explorers.
65.0	Yuma Proving Ground, AZ	Yuma Proving Ground, U.S. Army base, 30 miles NE of Yuma, Arizona, testing facility for new military weapons and equipment.
76.4	Laguna Army Airfiled, AZ	Laguna Army Airfield, military airport, Yuma Proving Ground, Yuma, Arizona.
79.1	Mittry Lake Wildlife Area, AZ	Mittry Lake, north of Yuma, Arizona, open to the public for hunting, fishing, swimming, boating, camping (no facilities); Laguna Diversion Dam on the Colorado River, Imperial County Route S24, between Yuma, Arizona and Winterhaven, California; Imperial Diversion Dam across the Arizona/California border, 18 miles NE of Yuma, Arizona.
92.4	Arizona Western College, AZ	Arizona Western College, Yuma, Arizona, public community college.
97.4	S Avenue 3 E	S Avenue 3 E bisects US Interstate Highway 8 to the south.
99.0	Junction: US Interstate Highway 8	Junction of US Highway 95 & US Interstate Highway 8, crosses the California border to the northwest.
99.9	Yuma, AZ	City of Yuma, county seat of Yuma County, Arizona, popular winter residence. Nearby attractions are the historic Yuma Territorial Prison, Yuma Quartermaster Depot State Historic Park, Kofa Mountains and wildlife sanctuary, Martinez and Mittry Lakes, and the Algodones Dunes. Also in Yuma are Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, which holds a yearly air show, and Yuma Proving Ground, an Army testing facility for new military equipment. Running along the north and west side of Yuma is the Colorado River.
