5.2	Milford, Pennsylvania Town Line	You are entering one of the oldest and most charming towns in Pa. and the Poconos. It abounds with beauty, lovely shopping, great restaurants and Inns. The streets are lined with Bradford Pear trees - and Milford celebrates a Pear Blossom Festival each spring.

5.7	Foster Hall	This beautiful building , known as Foster Hall, houses many fine businesses. Caticorner across the street is the Dimmick Inn which was founded in 1828 - you'll find this to be a great place for respite.
5.8	Detour to the Water Wheel Cafe	Instead of following Rte. 209 at the traffic light where the Dimmick Inn is - go straight - down the little hill and to the right on a one way street - along Mill Stream. At the end you will find the delightful Water Wheel cafe - along with wonderful little shops housing treasures beyond your imagination!
6.0	Milford Beach Turn Off	Milford Beach is a State boat launch, plus a sand beach along the Delaware. Plenty of fishing and the shad were running when we were there
6.7	Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area	This is the entrance. In the spring the woods are alive with dogwoods, Shad trees (aka service berry), black cherry and the aroma of honeysuckle permeating the air. In the fall - the foliage is gorgeous and the trees covered with bittersweet.
6.8	Entrance to bridge to New Jersey
